

EVALUATION OF ICDP

2015, SOUTH KOREA

Sangwon Yoon completed the ICDP facilitator education and training for his Master's programme at the Department of Special Needs Education at the University of Oslo. He received training from Professor Berit Johnsen.

As part of the requirements in order to complete his ICDP training, he carried out an ICDP project in his native Korea, that involved holding ten ICDP meetings with ten parents with developmental disabilities. The parents were recruited by the Jeju Parents' Network for People with Disabilities (JPNPD).

In order to work with parents Sangwon translated ICDP materials in Korean.

The project was also a research study and upon completion the study report was published by the Jeju Parents' Network for People with Disabilities (JPNPD) and it was submitted to the Educational Office in the Jeju Province.

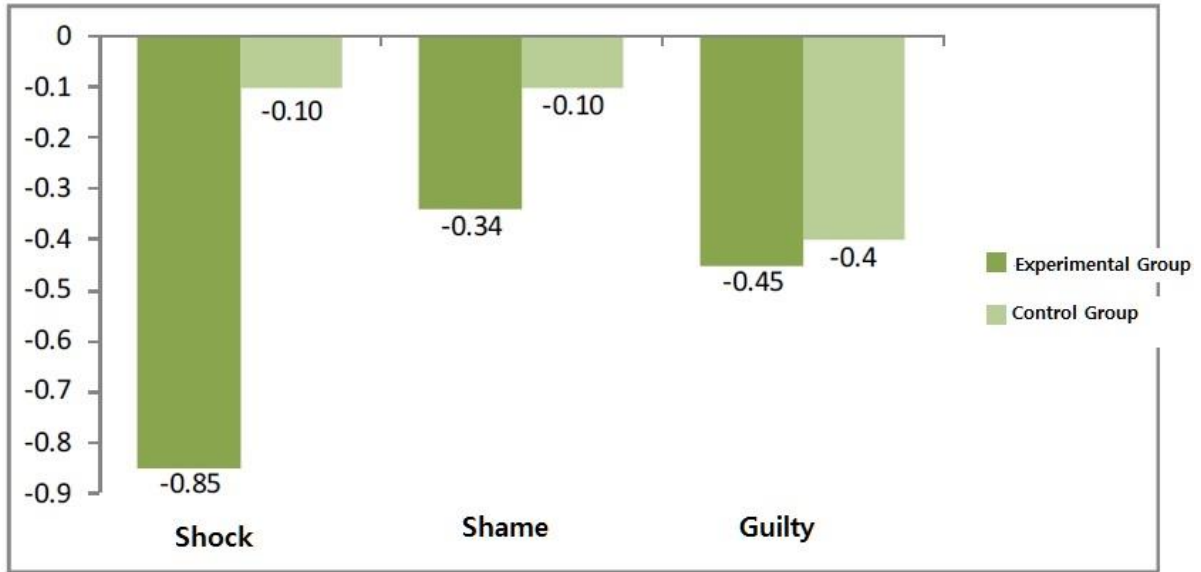
In this project, Sangwon tested the control and experimental groups before and after ICDP meetings.

He used three scales:

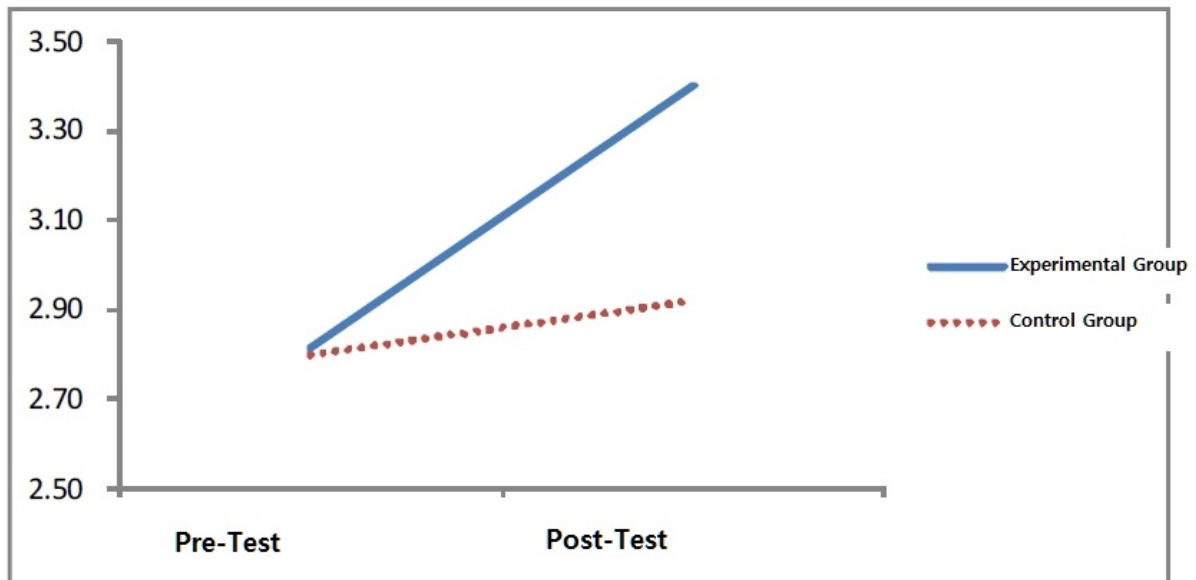
1. Parenting Sense of Competence,
2. The Sense of Disability Acceptance of Mother to Children with Disability,
3. and Child Abuse.

In 2017, Sangwon Yoon returned to the University of Oslo as a PhD candidate to complete his second ICDP project in Korea. The new project is linked to his PhD dissertation.

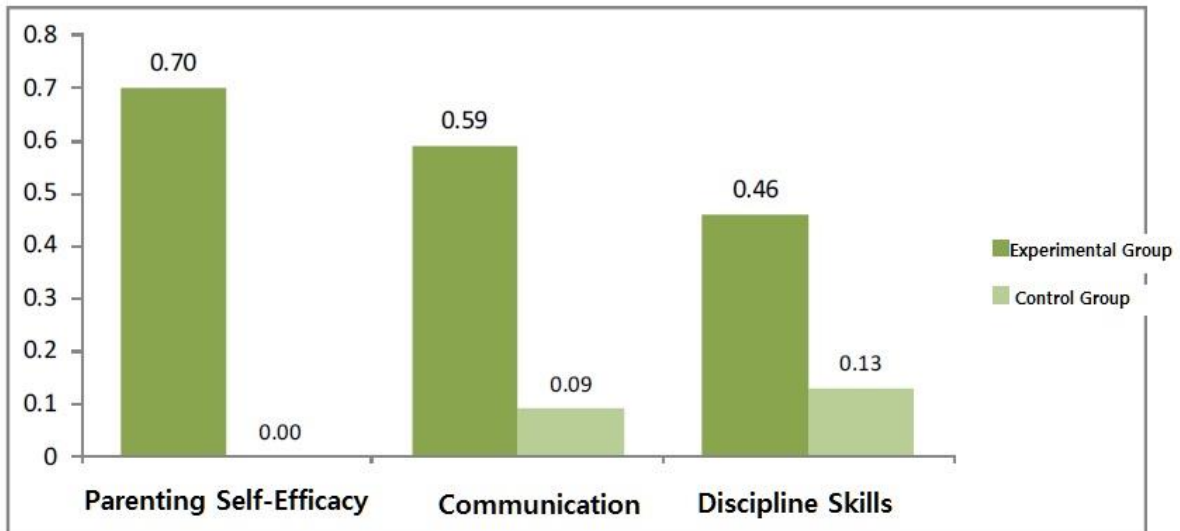
STUDY RESULTS OF SANGWON'S FIRST ICDP PROJECT ARE OUTLINED BELOW:



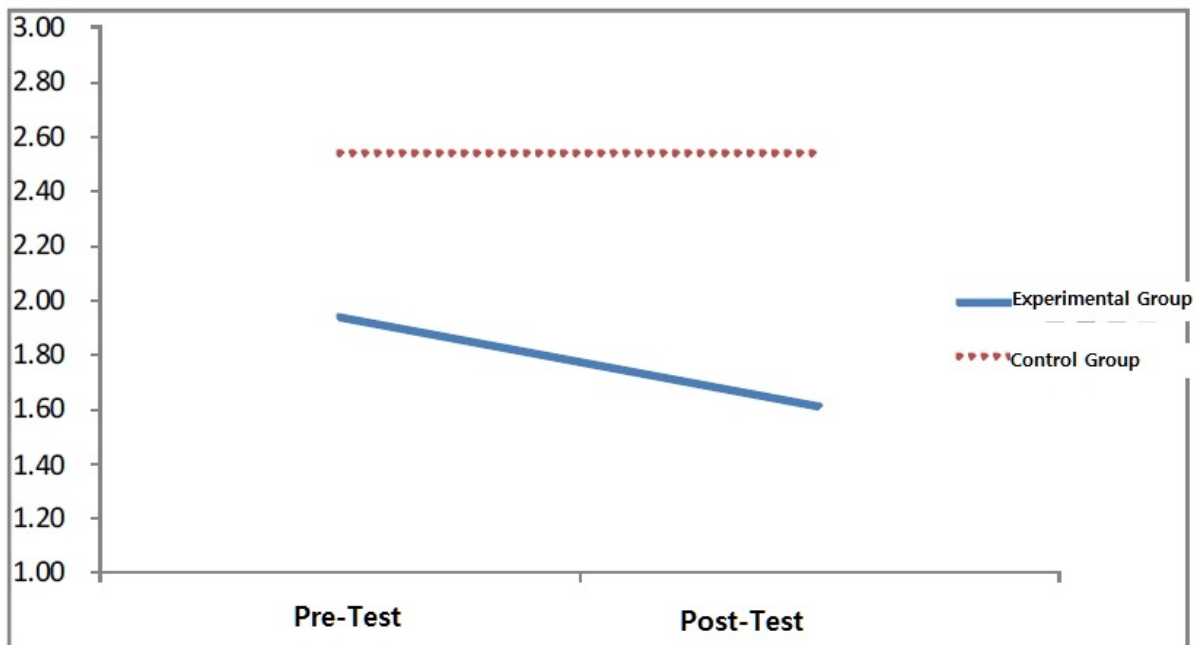
The Level of Disability Acceptance of Mother to Child with Disability Between Before and After ICDP



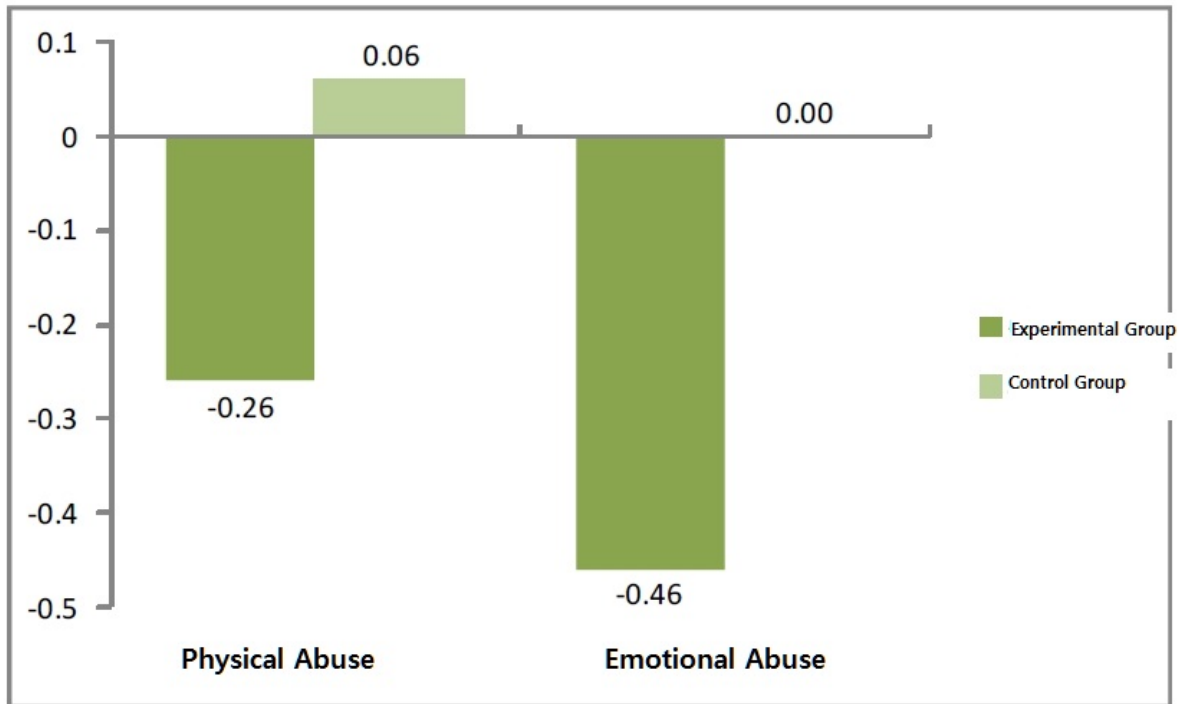
The Level of Parenting Sense of Competence Before and After ICDP
