In Sweden, the ICDP programme has been used for fifteen years and the experiences of those who used the programme demonstrate that there are many children in Sweden who benefitted as a result. This book contains twenty interviews with individuals and teams who have used the ICDP programme in maternal child health care, pre-school / school and social services. Karin Edenhammar, one of the founders of the ICDP Sweden Foundation conducted the interviews. The experience of using the program is consistently very good. Hopefully the book can also be used as inspiration for the further development of the ongoing ICDP work.



Empathetic leadership

This booklet describes the empathetic leadership that advances employees' cooperation and ability through compassion, presence and self-reflection; a leadership that ultimately supports health, community involvement and responsibility. The three dialogues of the ICDP programme are introduced as a way of developing a healthy dialogue between the leadership and their employees. The booklet also describes different brain functions to help leaders better understand their own, as well as their employees' feelings and reactions. It contains a number of practical exercises.



Guiding interaction in preschool

According to the preschool curriculum a preschool should provide children with a safe environment that simultaneously challenges and encourages play and activity. It should inspire children to explore the world. In a preschool, children should be met by adults who see the potential in each child and who involve themselves interactively with both the individual child and the group of children. With the help of the three dialogues for good interaction of the ICDP-programme this booklet offers guidance that can enhance adults' interactions with pre-schoolers.
