

## **KIWAKKUKI STARTS 2017 WITH ICDP FACILITATOR TRAINEES FROM MBULU NORTH -TANZANIA**

At the beginning of the year, on 17<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> of January 2017, a group of 13 ICDP facilitator trainees from Mbulu- Manyara Region visited a group of facilitators in Moshi- Tanzania to share experiences, and to learn more from other colleagues.

The Mbulu ICDP trainees had conducted 4-6 meetings with caregivers over a period of 3<sup>½</sup> months since November 2016 in their area.

They reported that the meetings were held in church, local leader's offices and one group held the meeting in a house of one of the trainees

Each group of 2-3 ICDP facilitator trainees presented the caregivers meetings they held and challenged they faced. After every group has presented, there was a discussions and they were all very active in the discussions.

The second day on 18<sup>th</sup> January the group had an opportunity to visit community based facilitators who have been trained initially as home visitors but later trained as ICDP facilitators. They shared experiences regarding care-givers meetings and although there are cultural differences still they have common understanding of ICDP.

The agenda of the 2 days workshop was completed as planned by the team: Martha Moen, Guunar Eide, Eglá Matechi and Velynice Monyo.

The group from Mbulu will complete 8 meetings by the end of January 2017 and thereafter will hold a certification ceremony in February 2017.
