

UPDATE FROM SILVIA BREABIN - 2017

Silvia Breabin has been working for many years at the Centre of Early Intervention in Kishinev, Moldova, where ICDP has had presence since 2013. She is one of the team of ICDP trainers at the Centre who have been applying the ICDP programme with children and parents who attend the institute. The Centre finds ICDP useful in relation to their work with parents of children with special needs and has offered the ICDP programme to other early intervention teams.



Silvia informs in her recent letter to ICDP that earlier this year she decided to move away from Moldova and that she is in fact already living in Romania, in an area situated between Sibiu, Sighisoara and Targu Mures.

“I would like to thank you for this great programme and hope to spread it to many more people in the future. I have already applied for my work permit and as soon as I receive it, my plan is to start training new groups in ICDP here in Romania.” - writes Silvia.

Silvia has a wide-ranging experience as ICDP trainer; in addition to her activities in Kishinev, she was also for a while part of the ICDP team involved in spreading the programme in Ukraine.

One of the several groups of facilitators that Silvia trained in Ukraine, continued to keep in touch with her on regular basis – this group is based in Vynnitsa.

Silvia now informs that the Vynnitsa facilitators still use the ICDP programme in the after school day centre for children which they run and that they also had the opportunity to participate in a TV show that discussed the work with the ICDP programme.

Silvia adds, that one of the facilitators was involved in training students from the Vynnytsya pedagogic university and that she also used ICDP as the topic of her master degree study.

According to Silvia some of the facilitators in Vynnytsya are very motivated to apply to ICDP for further training to become ICDP trainers.
